



Exhibition Criteria

UPDATED – January 28, 2025

1. The artist must be a member in good standing. Refer to Article III, section 3 of the by-laws: “to be a member in good standing”, member must be current on dues and be active on a committee.
2. BAA currently has 2 judged shows a year - WKNO and MBG (Memphis Botanic Garden). The same artwork may be displayed only one time per judged venue. If another judged show is added the same art may be shown one time at the new venue.
3. Hanging wire must be used, pulled taut and attached so it does not show when the painting is hung and keeps the piece snug to the wall. No sawtooth hangers or hooks are permitted.
4. Artwork must be framed or gallery wrapped with finished sides. Paint must be dry. Plexiglas may be used instead of glass.
5. The artist is responsible for his/her own artwork -- it is not insured.
6. The artist must deliver and pick up their artwork during the stated time frames or make arrangements for someone else to do so for them. Artwork will remain on exhibit until the end of the show.
7. Two (2) BAA artwork identification cards must be attached to the back of your artwork for any BAA exhibit. Printed cards are available at meetings or you may print your own from template provided. All cards should be printed on cardstock.
 - a. Your name and phone number
 - b. Title, medium, and price (or NFS)
 - c. Prints available: yes___ or no___.
8. For exhibitions that are judged, the artwork must be original. For other exhibits or shows, references (photos, prints, magazines, art books, etc.) may be used. When using references that are not your own, you should change at least 60% of the original image to make it your own. If the artwork is copied, the original

artist must be credited by signing the work as follows: Jane Doe after Pablo Picasso.

9. Judges for BAA judged shows may not be members of the Bartlett Art Association.
10. The Exhibition Committee can refuse artwork for an exhibit for the following reasons, and each venue has final decision on what can be displayed:
 - a. The artist is not in good standing with BAA,
 - b. Artwork has structural malfunctions,
 - c. Size or weight are more than can be accommodated by the venue, and
 - d. Inappropriate content.
11. Entry fees for BAA judged shows are as follows: \$10 for the first piece and \$5 for each subsequent piece entered. This money is used to pay the judge and for prizes.
12. Drop off artwork in the staging area shall be 10 – 10:15 am; we cannot guarantee your art will be hung after that time. After drop off, leave the exhibition area so as not to interfere with the Exhibition Committee's work. Placement of art will be determined by the Committee.
